Registration Documents

- Proof of **age verification** (certified copy of birth certificate, a duly attested baptism certificate, passport, or when none of these documents are obtained, an affidavit of the parent/guardian)
- Copy of your child's **immunization record**
- One form of **address verification**

Required Immunizations

- **Polio** – four (4) doses (3 are sufficient if last dose given after the 4th birthday)
- **Diphtheria, Tetanus and Pertussis (DPT/DTaP)** – five (5) doses (4 are sufficient if last dose given after the 4th birthday)
- **Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR)** – two (2) doses of each. Both after the first birthday
- **Hepatitis B** – three (3) doses
- **Chickenpox (varicella)** – two (2) doses, or documented history of disease by physician.
- **7th-12th Graders** - The above immunizations plus 1 additional dose of Diphtheria, Tetanus and Pertussis (DPT/DTaP)

Immunization records must be submitted to the school during registration. **If immunization records are not current, updated, and submitted to the school site by the first day of school, students will not be allowed to attend school.**

Personal belief exemptions are no longer accepted - per SB277

Other Medical Requirements

TB skin tests are required for students who have recently moved from countries where TB is prevalent (Latin America, Asia, Africa, and Eastern Europe).

Additional TK & Kindergarten Requirements

A physical examination: The “Report of Health Examination for School Entry” form must be completed by a physician, less than 6 months before entry to kindergarten.

An oral health assessment: Required by May 31 of the first year of school.

Kindergarten: A child must be five years old on or before **September 1, 2020**

Transitional Kindergarten: A child must be five years old between **September 2 and December 2, 2020**
